- APPLICATION FEE NIL
- REGISTRATION FEE \$500 PAYABLE ONLY WHEN THE APPLICATION IS APPROVED.
- PLEASE NOTE REGISTRATION/ANNUAL FEES include Public Liability Insurance whilst the dog and Team are in full compliance with PAD Policies, Procedures and ByLaws
- AFFILIATE ASSOCIATE FEE \$100, non-refundable. If an Applicant does not yet have a dog, but needs assistance with pre-approval with Residential, Work or Education environments, they must complete the full process as an Applicant. If for some reason they withdraw from registration after being provided with the appropriate Residential or Access and Integration documentation, the application fee is forfeit. If the Application proceeds to Registration, the application fee will be applied to the amount owing.
- ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE Due January 1st , each year, from the first year after Registration Fees are paid.
- REPLACEMENT FEE – JACKET \$60 Jackets lost or damaged incur a replacement fee. Jackets remain the property of PAD at all times.
- ALTERNATE HANDLER ID CARD No charge for an Alternate Handler required for a minor. SECOND HANDLER ID CARD \$20, plus Agreement forms to be signed.
- PUBLIC ACCESS – TRAINING 1 FREE – PASA – Public Accesses Standards Assessment - Initial Assessment for Public Access Training or Certification for the probationary period is free.
- PUBLIC ACCESS – TRAINING 2 Amount is set with Annual Fees each year – If a Handler Team fails to pass the PAD PAST - Public Access Standards Test, for the 3 year Public Access Standards Certification (PASC) after the 12-month probationary period, they may be assessed to continue training for one more year. A fee applies to the Assessment and replacement of the Registration Certificate indicating the extended expiry date. If after two years, the Team is still not certified suitable for PASC, the Team will be de registered.
- PAD PUBLIC ACCESS STANDARDS CERTIFICATION To be set Annually Please note: the term PAT refers to the Queensland GHAD public access test. It is not a requirement under the DDA1992 and does not indicate the right/ or lack of rights, to public access of an Assistance Dog Team operating under Federal Legislation. The DDA 1992 sets out three specific requirements: - a) The Handler has a proven disability that is supported by an Assistance Dog; and b) The Handler

- can prove the dog is trained for appropriate hygiene and behaviour in public places; and c)
The dog is maintained at a level of hygiene, grooming and health, acceptable in public places.
- The PAD Public Access Standards Certification, (PASC) acknowledges that PAD has taken these requirements into account when registering a Handler Team. PAD PASC is for 3 year, provided the Handler maintains the standards of training and public access, along with compliance with all PAD Policies and Procedures
